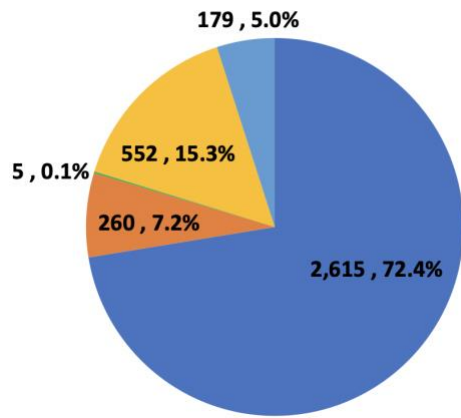


72.4% of Warren County misdemeanor charges were for nonviolent and non-DWI related traffic offenses, 15.3% were for other nonviolent offenses, 7.2% were for DWI and related offenses, 5.0% were for violent offenses, and 0.1% were for nonviolent ordinance violations.

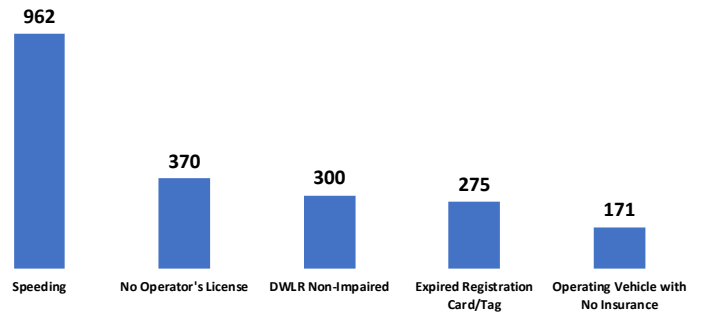

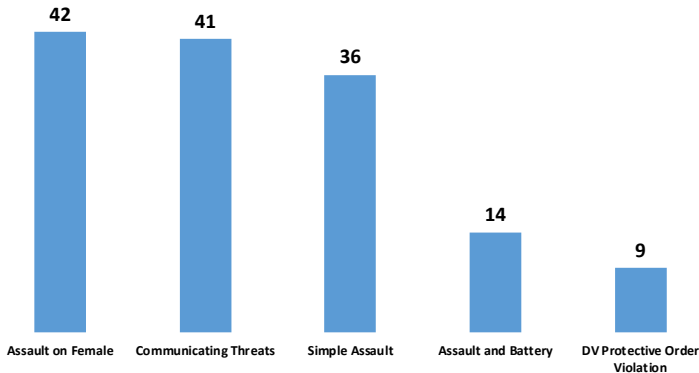
#### Most Commonly Charged Ordinance Violations



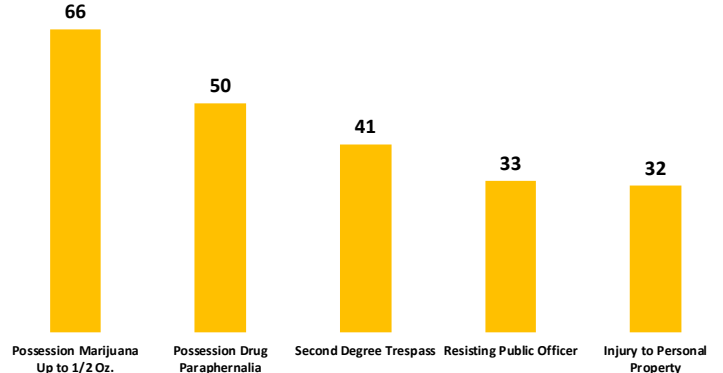
#### Most Commonly Charged Non-DWI Related Traffic Misdemeanors



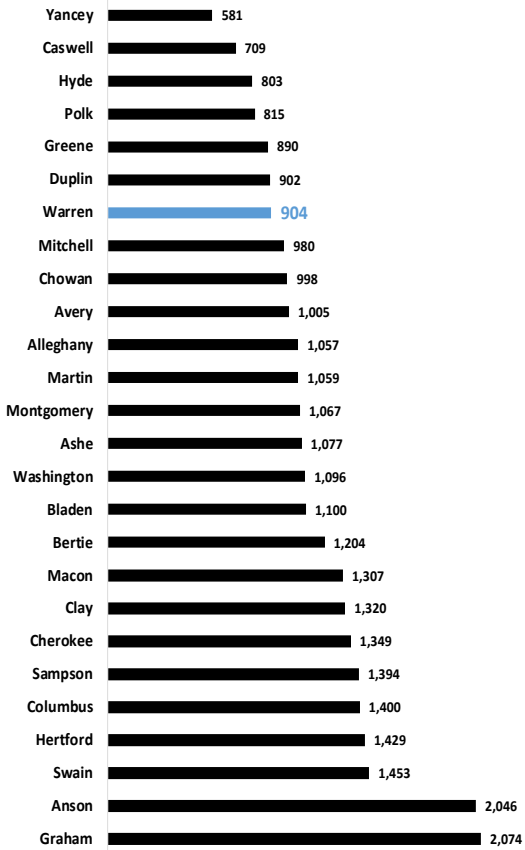
#### Most Commonly Charged Violent Misdemeanors



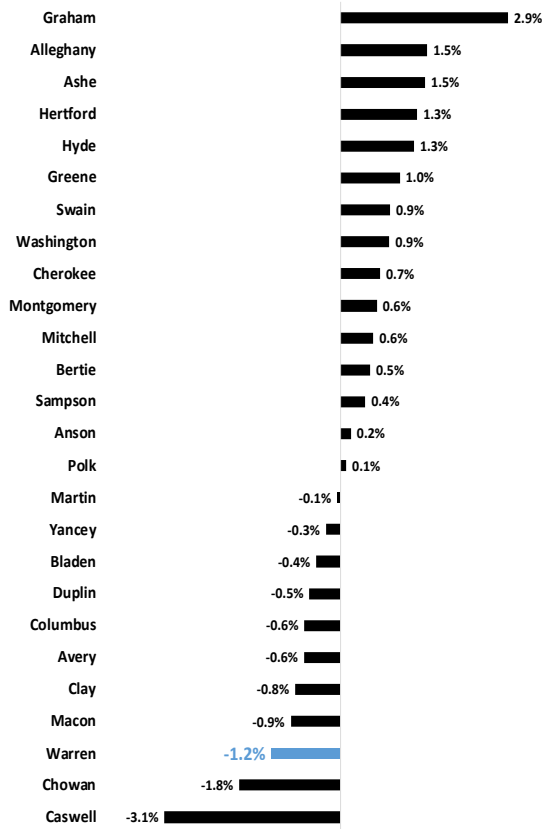
#### Most Commonly Charged Other Nonviolent Misdemeanors



2019 Violent Misdemeanor Charges Per 100,000 Population Among Noncore Counties

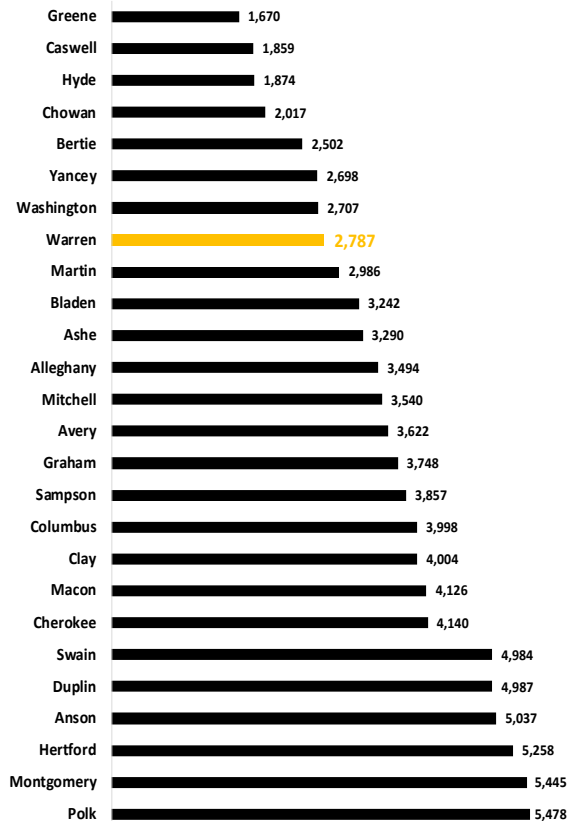


2018 - 2019 Change in Percentage Violent Misdemeanor Charges Among Noncore Counties

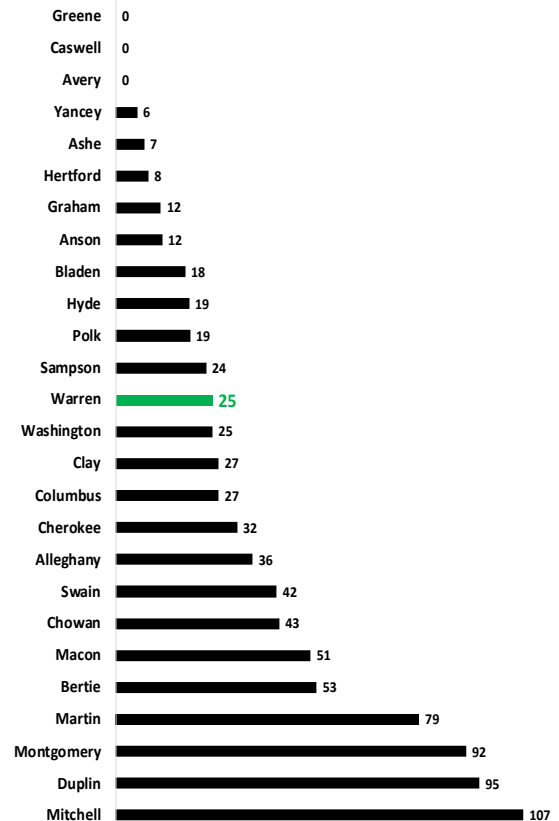


Among noncore counties<sup>1</sup>, Warren County had the seventh lowest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **904**. Between 2018 and 2019, Warren County had the third largest decrease in violent misdemeanor charges among noncore counties at **1.2** percentage points.

2019 Ordinance Violation Charges Per 100,000 Population Among Noncore Counties

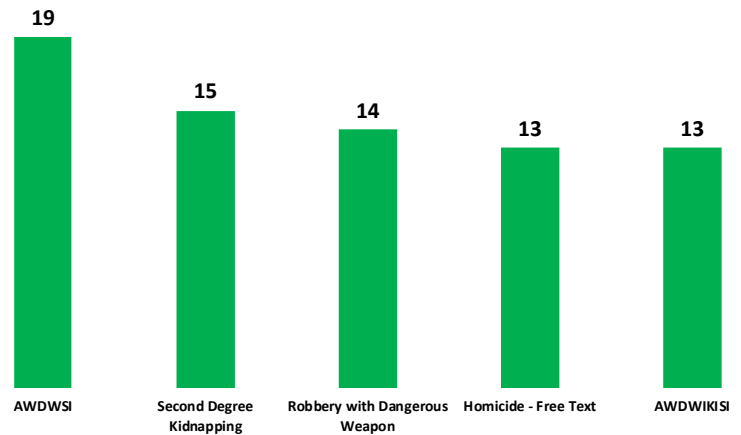


Among noncore counties<sup>1</sup>, Warren County had the eighth highest number of other nonviolent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **2,787**. Warren County had the 13<sup>th</sup> lowest number of ordinance violation charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **25**.

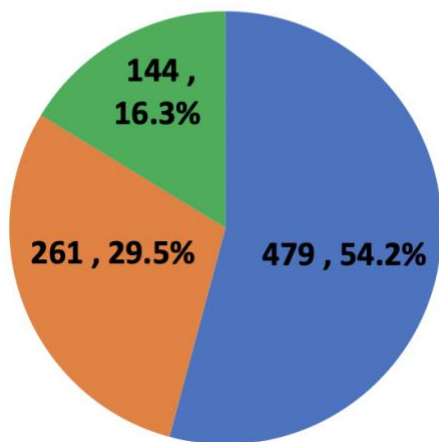

Most Commonly Charged Violent Felonies

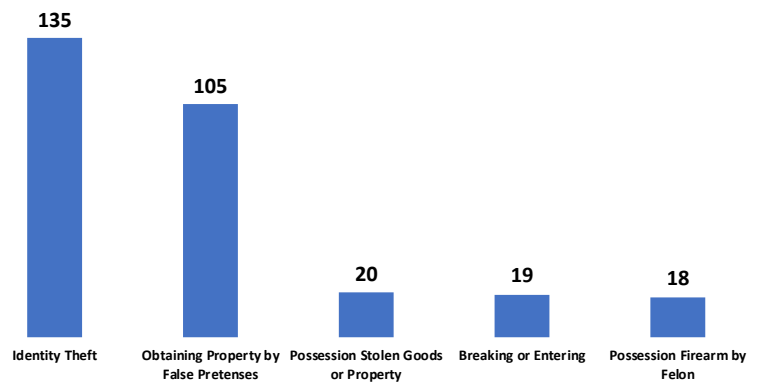

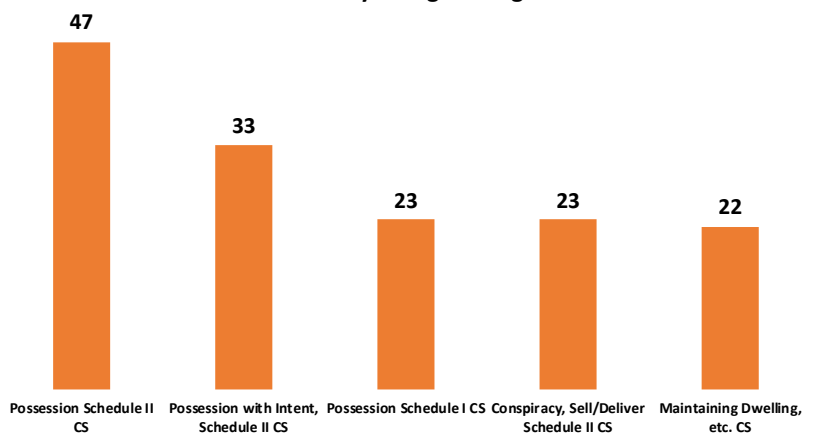

Most Commonly Charged Other Nonviolent Felonies



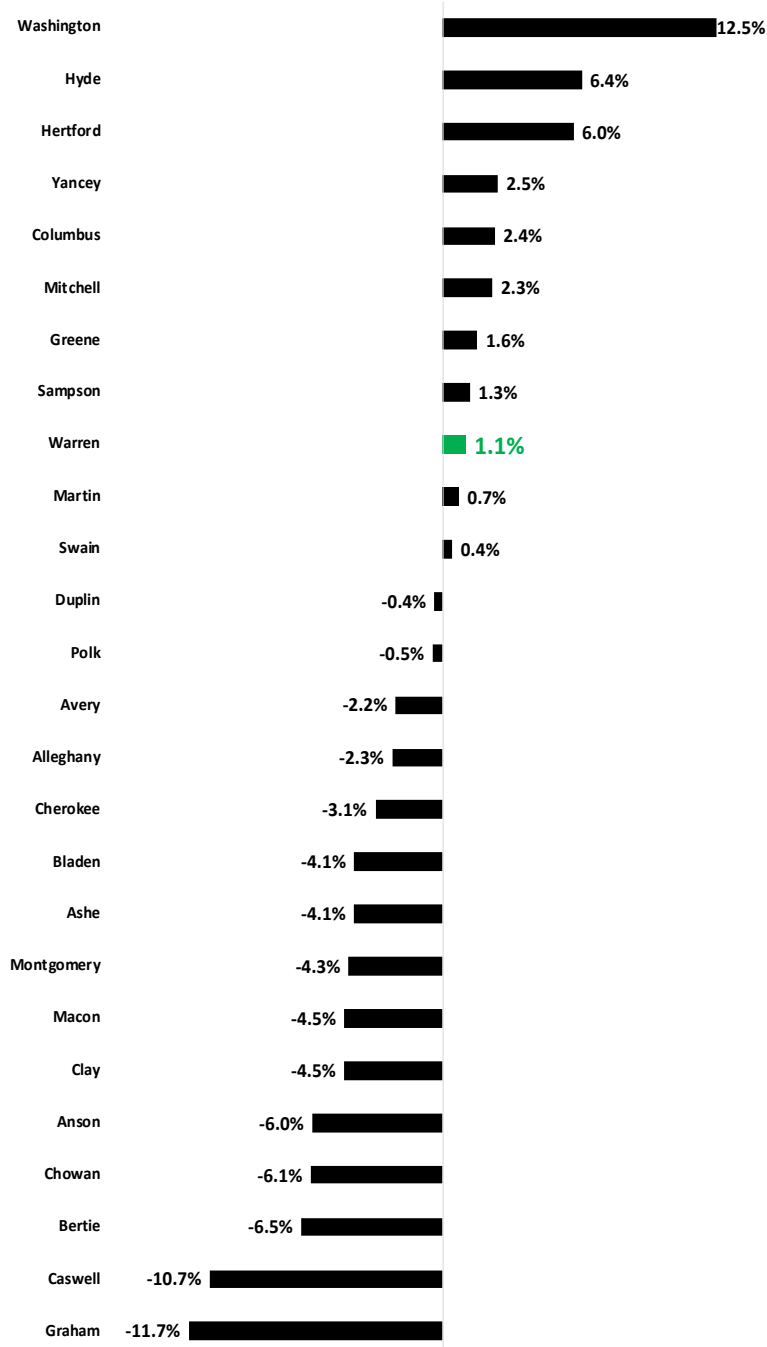
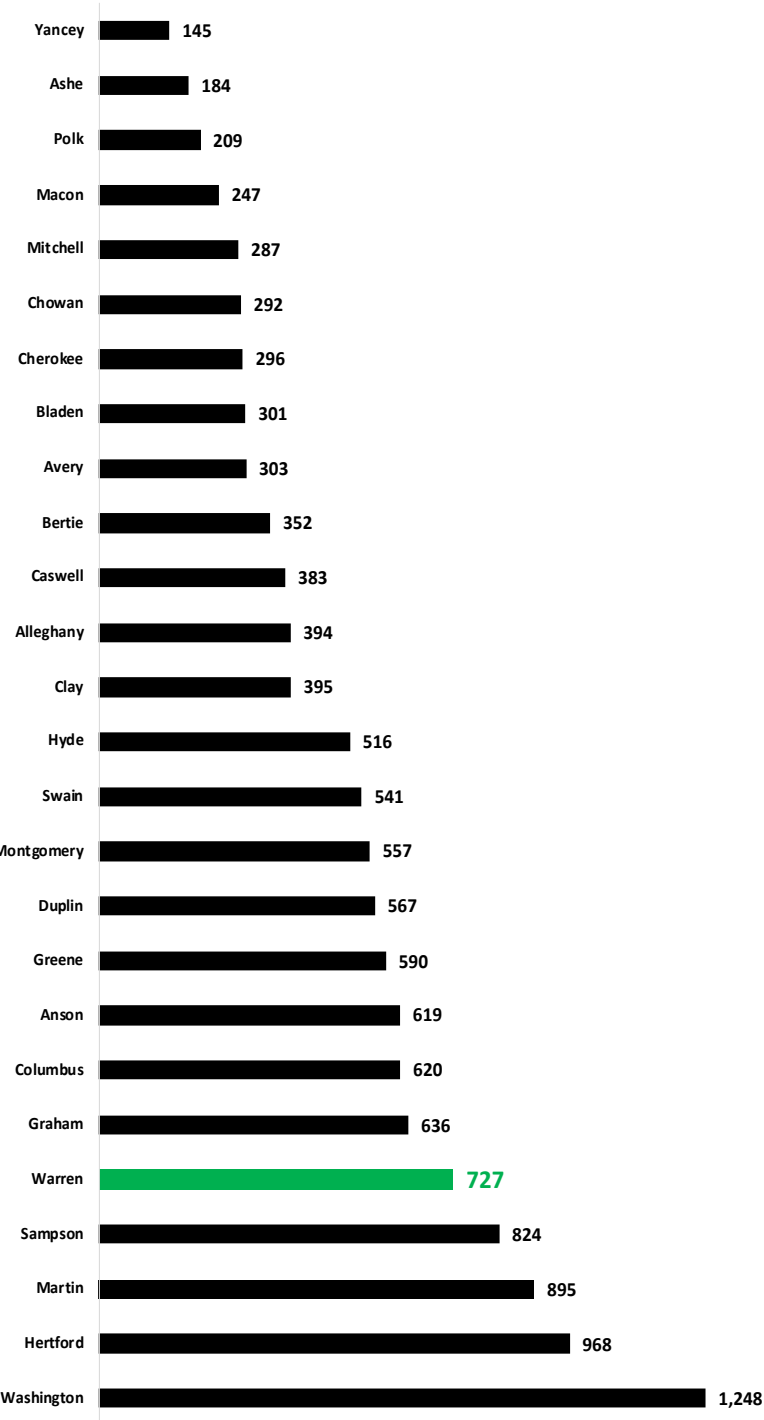
Most Commonly Charged Drug Felonies



Among noncore counties<sup>1</sup>, Warren County had the fifth highest number of violent felony charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **727**. Between 2018 and 2019, Warren County had the ninth largest increase in violent felony charges among noncore counties at **1.1** percentage points.
