
72.4% of Warren County misdemeanor charges were for nonviolent and non-DWI related traffic offenses, **15.3%** were for other nonviolent offenses, **7.2%** were for DWI and related offenses, **5.0%** were for violent offenses, and **0.1%** were for nonviolent ordinance violations.






Among noncore counties¹, Warren County had the seventh lowest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 904. Between 2018 and 2019, Warren County had the third largest decrease in violent misdemeanor charges among noncore counties at 1.2 percentage points.

2019 Ordinance Violation Charges Per 100,000 Population Among Noncore Counties




16.3% of Warren County felony charges were for violent felonies, **29.5%** were for nonviolent drug felonies, and **54.2%** were for other nonviolent felonies.




Most Commonly Charged Violent Felonies

2019 Charged Felonies




Most Commonly Charged Other Nonviolent Felonies
