





77.2% of Washington County misdemeanor charges were for nonviolent and non-DWI related traffic offenses, 13.3% were for other nonviolent offenses, 3.9% were for DWI and related offenses, 5.4% were for violent offenses, and .1% were for nonviolent ordinance violations.


2019 Charged Misdemeanors













Most Commonly Charged Other Nonviolent Misdemeanors






2018 - 2019 Change in Percentage Violent Misdemeanor **Charges Among Noncore Counties**




Among noncore counties1, **Washington County** had the 12th highest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 1,096. Between 2018 and 2019, **Washington County** had the eighth largest increase in violent misdemeanor charges among noncore counties at .9 percentage points.

Among noncore counties¹, **Washington County** had the seventh lowest number of other nonviolent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 2,707. Washington County had the 13th highest number of ordinance violation charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at 25.




2019 Other Nonviolent Misdemeanor Charges Per 100.000




31.4% of Washington County felony charges were for violent felonies, **12.1%** were for nonviolent drug felonies, and **56.6%** were for other nonviolent felonies.




2019 Charged Felonies






- Nonviolent Felonies, Other

Among noncore counties¹, Washington County had the highest number of violent felony charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **1,248**. Between 2018 and 2019, Washington County had the largest increase in violent felony charges among noncore counties at **12.5** percentage points.
