


67.8% of Wilson County misdemeanor charges were for nonviolent and non-DWI related traffic offenses, **20.3%** were for other nonviolent offenses, **4.1%** were for DWI and related offenses, **6.7%** were for violent offenses, and **1.1%** were for nonviolent ordinance violations.

■ Nonviolent, Non-DWI Related Traffic Misdemeanor Charges






Most Commonly Charged Violent Misdemeanors




Most Commonly Charged Non-DWI Related Traffic Misdemeanors



Most Commonly Charged Ordinance Violations




Most Commonly Charged Other Nonviolent Misdemeanors

2018 - 2019 Change in Percentage Violent Misdemeanor Charges Among Noncore Counties




Among micropolitan counties¹, Wilson County had the 13th lowest number of violent misdemeanor charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **1,191**. Between 2018 and 2019, Wilson County had the 10th largest decrease in violent misdemeanor charges among micropolitan counties at .6 percentage points.


2019 Other Nonviolent Misdemeanor Charges Per 100,000 Population Among Noncore Counties






20.0% of Wilson County felony charges were for violent felonies, 34.9% were for nonviolent drug felonies, and 45.2% were for other nonviolent felonies.


Most Commonly Charged Violent Felonies



2019 Charged Felonies




Most Commonly Charged Drug Felonies



Most Commonly Charged Other Nonviolent Felonies



Among micropolitan counties¹, Wilson County had the fourth highest number of violent felony charges per 100,000 residents in 2019 at **1,002**. Between 2018 and 2019, Wilson County had the 14th largest increase in violent felony charges among micropolitan counties at **1.7** percentage points.
